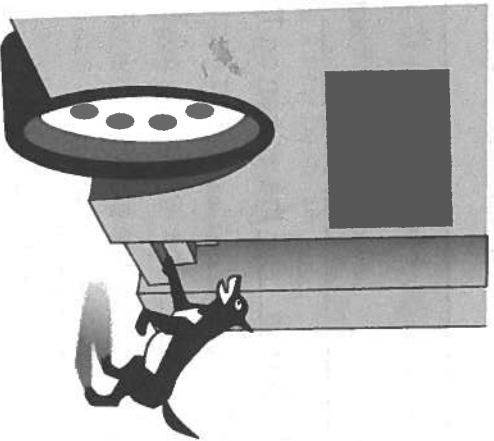


EDDY GOES FOR A WALK
